1	TVBC Grounds Maintenance Contracts	Cllr Gwynne and I had a very good meeting with TVBC regarding grounds maintenance and new items from the project list. See Separate agenda items.
2.	Speed Limit Reminder Sign	We have received a response from HCC. Cllr Critchley is reviewing it. We have a meeting 15/4 to progress. The ex REPC Speedwatch portable unit had been sent for calibration and to have the missing parts supplied.
3.	Handrails in Main Stairway	These have now been replaced. There are still some treatments to apply. Awaiting a quiet period to allow drying.
4.	Projects List	Greening Romsey, Asset stickers, Woodley parking see separate agenda items.
5.	Christmas Lights	I am awaiting the quote for the ongoing repairs. I have discussed this with the Contractor SJT and will certainly within the Budget in place.
6.	Lengthsman	He is starting with the regular bus shelter cleans. The town entry signs will be cleaned next. The Speed reminder sign brackets will then be fitted.
