Team Abbotswood raised £1642 plus gift aid



Our Session Routine

We would like to update you all on our Session Routine. Some things may change from day to day but we always try to keep the things we do roughly the same.

10.30 Snack time.

The children are encouraged to wash their hands and sit down at the table. We sing a morning song as well as a hello song to each child. We use Makaton signing throughout. The children may or may not have a picture prompt and some friends enjoy the role of helping to tidy up after snack and clean the table.

11.15 Bucket time.

This activity builds upon a child's attention span and develops concentration. It develops their ability to be able to attend an activity for extended periods of time, and prompts shared attention.

A now and next board will be used as well as simple language. The activities are visually motivating and stimulating. The children will be asked if they would like 'more' or if they would like the activity to 'finish', and they are encouraged to sign their response.

Bucket time will only go on for 5 minutes as a maximum.

11.50 Choosing songs

At the end of end session we sing our favourite nursery rhymes. Each child has a turn to pick a song from our choices board, either by using eye contact, pointing or handing us the picture card. Just before parent/guardians return to the room we sing our Teddy bear song which indicates that the session has now finished.

In between the children may free play with various activities we have available both inside and outside.
