

Romsey Markets General Information

Romsey holds a General Market on Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, located in The Cornmarket and The Market Place, Romsey

The management of the Markets is controlled by a partnership agreement between Bradbeers (contact is Property Manager Mark Hall) and Romsey Town Council using historic permissions granted by The Lord of the Manor, Lord Mountbatten (Contact is the through Broadlands Estate Office)

Market Hours

Trading to commence by 8.30am and continue to normally 2.30pm, traders can continue after this time if they wish to.

Types of Stalls

As a small Market our aim is to have one of each trader type. Traders are expected to attend every market they are booked on unless the management agree cancellation due to adverse weather.

Market Fees

The standard fee for a single day use of a 3 x 3 metre pitch is £25, larger pitch fee are subject to negotiation. Traders provide their own gazebo and other equipment. Whilst we endeavour to provide the same pitch for regular traders the management reserves the right to relocate pitches to meet operational or external needs.

Charity Stalls

The management offer two free Charity stalls at each Market, these must be pre-booked and must follow same rules as other traders, includes hold Public Liability Insurance

Certification

Food stalls must hold and display a current Food Hygiene Certificate (excludes fresh fruit and veg stalls)

All stalls must have Public Liability Cover for minimum £2M, copy of certificate must be lodged with Market Managers before trading starts and on annual renewal.

Vehicles

Once gazebo is erected and stock unloaded all vehicles must be removed from Market area, if parked in TVBC Pay and Display car parks the appropriate fee must be paid. Do not park in the Aldi carpark that is controlled by Parking Eye with severe penalties for misuse

Electric Hookups

There are limited 240v power outlets at each location that must be pre-booked. Traders must discuss equipment to be used with the management prior to connection as capacity is limited

Market Regulations
